

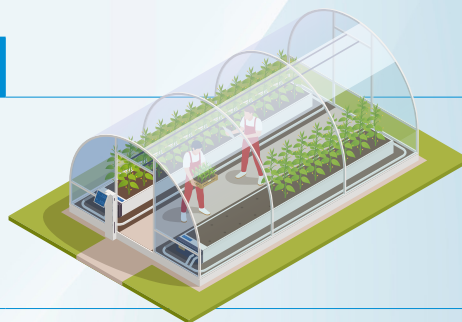


Agricultural Health and Food Safety (AHFS)

A good Agricultural Health and Food Safety (AHFS) System includes:
 Adequate Legislative Framework, Human Resources, Physical Infrastructure, Equipment and Services for the Protection of Animal, Plant and Human Health and Life and the Promotion of Safe Production of and Trade in Agricultural Products.

Weak AHFS Systems can affect:

- Trade Opportunities
- Investments in Agriculture
- Environmental Preservation
- Socio-Economic Development of a Country



AHFS Systems cover several areas such as:
